



NOMINATION CRITERIA

CATEGORIES: Individuals may be nominated to represent one of seven categories.

- Activity Participant
- Athlete
- Activity Sponsor / Athletic Coach
- Official / Adjudicator
- Administrator
- Major Contributor / Sponsor
- Lifetime Achievement

REQUIREMENTS:

Activity Participant & Athlete:

- Graduate of any current or former ASAA member school. Or a graduate of any diploma-granting Alaskan high school which predates the formation of ASAA in 1956.
- Five years following the date of high school graduation.
- Earned a minimum of two varsity letters in one sport, one varsity letter in two sports, multi-year participation, or brought recognition to the school by athletic, or activity accomplishments.
- Maintains exemplary life of community service and good character, which reflects credit to the person, the school and society.
- Exemplary academic achievement shall be considered a desirable qualification.

Activity Sponsor / Athletic Coach, Official / Adjudicator, & Administrator

- Five years following retiring from interscholastic service.
- Evidence of an outstanding career.
- Must have had a direct and significant impact on high school athletics and/or activities.

Major Contributor / Sponsor

- Someone other than an activity participant, athlete, activity sponsor/coach, official/adjudicator or administrator.
- Made an extraordinary contribution resulting in a significant benefit, or reflects great credit, to the school or to ASAA.

- Examples such as athletic administrator, state association staff member, sports medicine provider, volunteer, contributor, or media personnel.

Lifetime Achievement

- Someone that qualifies in several categories
- Five years following retiring from interscholastic service.
- Evidence of an outstanding career.
- Must have had a direct and significant impact on high school athletics and/or activities.
- Example; an outstanding athlete that became a coach, an official and a principal.

NOMINATION INSTRUCTIONS

All information requested on the nomination form must be provided. Supporting materials that substantiate the nominee's accomplishments or contributions should also accompany the nomination form.

REQUIRED MATERIALS: (email to sandi@asaa.org)

- Online nomination form submitted or printable form completed
- Two Letters of recommendation, which specifically address the nominee's time in high school (student, work, volunteer, etc.).
- High quality current portrait-type photo.

SUPPORTING MATERIALS: (email to sandi@asaa.org)

- Media clippings, articles, etc.
- Resume
- Awards, certifications, accommodations, etc.
- Photos
- For cases in which supporting materials are difficult to obtain, additional letters of recommendation may be substituted.
